Sponsorship

Detail

Item 33 (1) of the ASIEQ constitution and Rules states:

The funds of the association may be derived from annual membership subscriptions, donations, fund-raising activities, grants, interest and other sources approved by the executive committee.

Sponsorship can be both financial and in kind support.

ASIEQ may automatically accept sponsorship from:

- An ordinary member
- An associate member
- Local government
- State government
- Federal government

Sponsorship may be accepted outside of the above organisations. The executive committee may consider any offers of sponsorship but will only accept such offers from organisations that align with the Objects of ASIEQ as listed in the constitution and rules.

Any sponsorship agreements endorsed by the executive committee should be made in writing, outlining clearly the agreement between both parties and signed by both parties.

Sponsorship will not be accepted from (but is not limited to):

- A political lobby organisation
- A drug company
- An organisation that is not of good repute
